



The Homefinder service is delivered by Golden Lane Housing (GLH), a specialist housing charity established by Royal Mencap Society in 1998.

Their aim is to help people with a learning disability have more choices about where and how they live.

How does it work?

- 1 It uses existing schemes run by housing departments.
- 2 It supports people to rent directly from the private rental sector.
- 3 SWLH will lease properties from the private sector and sublet them to people with learning disabilities.

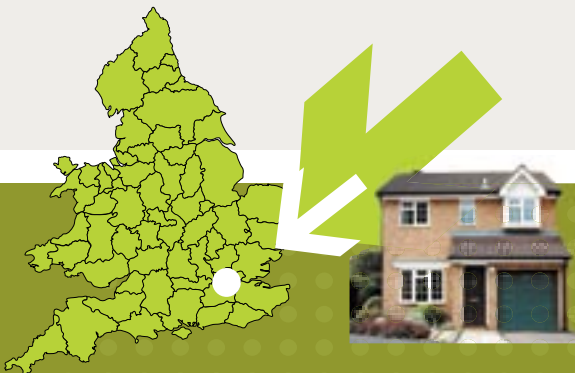
What are the benefits?

What will the Homefinders service actually do?

- Receive referrals.
- Undertake a housing assessment for approval by you and your client.
- Review and present the options available with costs and timescales.
- A matching service which presents sharing opportunities.
- Liaise with the local housing department about rent deposit schemes.
- Carry out property searches and accompanied viewings.
- Find suitable accommodation.
- Review quality of the support arrangements.
- Provide a unique housing support service once people are housed.



What will social services and others have to do?

- Ensure the correct support package is in place.
- Carry out a risk assessment for all sharing opportunities.
- Ensure people get help with individual and household budgeting.

There are no fees before 1 April 2011.

After moving in, tenants pay a fee of £10 per person per week for supported landlord services provided by GLH.
